## The Chamber Orchestra of the Triangle

Founded in 1982 under the name St. Stephen's Chamber Orchestra by Dr. Joseph Kitchen, the ensemble was re-organized in 1988 under the artistic direction of Lorenzo Muti.

From the beginning the orchestra was received with genuine respect and enthusiasm by the community, as well as by critics. Today, it is considered one of the finest professional ensembles in North Carolina and the Southeast. With its elite core of musicians, the orchestra continues to present well-chosen and unusual repertoire in concerts that combine technical accuracy and strong musicianship. Throughout its 29 years of existence the ensemble has performed with first rate soloists, such as Gary Graffman and Claude Frank as well as some of the brightest rising stars of the musical stage, including Mimi Stillman, Alexander Fiterstein, Lise de la Salle, Vivian Hagner, Timothy Fain, Nicholas Kitchen and many others.
